Sir,

This is with reference to your letter dated 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 in reply to the Commission's letter dated 03.06.2008 regarding appointment of third party meter testing laboratory and the issues raised by you regarding the applicable standards and time frame etc. In this regard the following may be noted:

- i. A copy of the NABL accreditation of CPRI was handed over to your representative during their visit to the Commission and perusal of the certificate clearly indicates CPRI's NABL Accreditation for its mobile Laboratory and the applicable Indian standard as, IS 15707:2006. This is in line with the Clause 18(2) of CEA Regulations 2006 on metering and Billing, according to which testing of a consumer meter may be carried out through a NABL Accredited laboratory. The provisions given in the relevant NABL Accreditation Certificate of CPRI and IS 15707:2006 would be applicable regarding testing of meters.
- ii. Regarding time frame for repeated testing of meters, the provisions given in clause 38 (g) of the Supply Code Regulations on testing of meters would be applicable.
- iii. It may kindly be noted that CPRI is a renowned Government laboratory with national and international accreditations and their accreditation by NABL for its mobile laboratory establishes the fact that it is equipped for carrying out testing of meters onsite. Its use as third party testing agency by consumers should go a long way in instilling confidence in the consumers about the accuracy of their meters.

2. It is, therefore, desired that the testing of meters through this arrangement may be initiated immediately so that the consumers do not have to face any difficulty.
