BRPL & Havells India partner to promote safety among consumers

BRPL and Havells India Limited (HIL) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote safety among BRPL's over 25 lakh consumers in South and West Delhi. Under the agreement, two innovative programs are being launched:



- Attractively priced ELCB/RCCBs: BRPL consumers will be offered the next-generation technology devices (RCCB/ELCB*) at attractive rates. These are important human protection devices that detect "current leakage" (earth leakage) in one's premises, automatically disconnecting the electricity supply to the premises, thus preventing serious mishaps.
- **Training of RWA nominated electricians**: A unique training program approved by the National Skill Development Council (NSDC), is being launched for 1000 RWA nominated electricians & linemen. Qualifying electricians will be Havells and NSDC certified and granted Rs 500/ through DBT under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), as also 3 years personal accident insurance of Rs 2 lakh, covering death and permanent disability.

BSES Discoms fully geared-up for the summer months

Delhi's peak power demand during the summers of 2020 may breach the 7850 MW mark. Last summers, it had crossed 7400 MW, highest everrecorded in the national capital. Arrangements have been firmed up by BSES discoms to source adequate electricity to meet the power demand. These arrangements include long term PPAs and banking arrangements with other states.
