Putting green-foot forward: 2200 trees planted

Our goal should be to plant trees and spread the awareness on healthy environment. Keeping this in mind, 1700 trees were planted in Government schools in Nangloi, Peeragarhi and Bakkarwala. Another, 500 trees were planted at the Gram Sabha, Mundka.
