



Alongside lending a helping hand and reaching-out to the needy to minimise the impact of Covid-19 on their lives, BRPL' CSR programs are also focusing on the traditional activities. During the month, the CSR programs continued with the annual tree plantation drive, spruced up toilets in schools and renovated crematoriums.

Twenty toilets repaired, will benefit 4800 students

Utilising the closure of schools during the Corona pandemic, BRPL renovated 12 toilets in 4 government schools in West Delhi. It will benefit around 1200 students once they rejoin the schools after the pandemic. Focused on sanitation and hygiene, BRPL has been renovating toilets in schools for a while now. During the last FY alone, around 100 toilets were repaired, benefiting over 40000 students.



Taking advantage of the rainy season, BRPL continues with the tree plantation exercise

Taking advantage of the monsoons and favourable conditions for planting trees, BRPL' CSR programs continued to build on the annual tree-plantation drive that started last month. After planting over 11,000 trees in July, around 8,000 trees were planted in August. Apart from CRPF Camp, Jharonda Kalan in West Delhi, trees were also planted in the Delhi Government and MCD Schools.



Renovating 7 crematoriums under Project Dignity

Doing its bit to give dignity to the departed soul's last journey and to provide comfort to the family and the loved ones during the last rites, BRPL has been renovating crematoriums. After starting work on the renovation of three crematoriums in July, work on renovation on four more was started in August. These are located in Munirka, Dakshinpuri, Chattarpur and Tuglakabad. During a survey, it was found that many crematoriums did not have proper facilities like chairs, benches, exhaust fans, fans and proper sanitation. As part of the exercise, these will be renovated and provided the missing facilities.

Earlier, under the CSR programs, renovation and upgradation of three Crematoria in South Delhi was undertaken, including a Pet Crematorium (Paws to Heaven), Muktidham Crematorium, Lodhi Road and one in Kalkaji.
