



Through its CSR programs, even during the Corona pandemic, BRPL has been helping the needy, trying to minimise its impact. The discom has been providing dry food rations, sanitisers and soaps at the door-steps of the thousands of residents of several JJ clusters. Additionally, discom promoted Women Self Help Groups are stitching affordable & reusable masks for thousands of people residing in the slums of West Delhi. Besides helping these women supplement their loss of income during the pandemic, they are also being distributed amongst the needy and the vulnerable population.

Additionally, during July, as part of the CSR outreach programs, we also undertook a tree plantation drive, renovated toilets in schools and started work on the renovation of crematoriums.

School toilets renovated during the Covid break

Utilising the closure of schools during the Corona pandemic, BRPL renovated 12 toilets in 4 government schools in West Delhi. It will benefit around 1200 students once they rejoin the schools after the pandemic. Focused on sanitation and hygiene, BRPL has been renovating toilets in schools for a while now. During the last FY alone, around 100 toilets were repaired, benefiting over 40000 students.



Putting green-foot forward: Thousands of trees planted

BRPL cares for the environment and like Delhi's residents; it too is concerned about the incidence of growing pollution. Doing its bit, BRPL routinely plants trees in its licensed area. In July, we restarted our annual tree plantation drive. In the mega drive, BRPL, in partnership with CRPF, planted thousands of trees at the CRPF Camp, Jharonda Kalan, Delhi. Apart from this, trees were also planted at the Delhi Government schools in South and West Delhi. These locations were carefully chosen to ensure their regular watering and high survivability of the planted samplings.



Renovating crematoriums under Project Dignity

BSES touches all aspects of peoples lives, including in their final journey. Doing its bit to give dignity to the departed soul's last journey and to provide comfort to the family and the loved ones during the last rites, BRPL has been renovating crematoriums. After completing the renovation and upgradation of three Crematoria in South Delhi, including a Pet Crematorium (Paws to Heaven), Muktidham Crematorium, Lodhi Road and the one in Kalkaji, the discom has now started the renovation work at three more Crematoriums at Hari Nagar, Uttam Nagar and Khayala in West Delhi.
