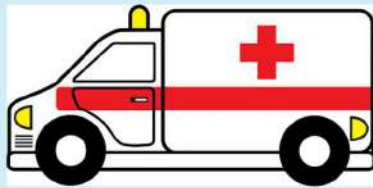

BRPL donating fully equipped ambulances

Extending the scope of the programs, BRPL is donating three fully equipped ambulances for the use of Delhi Government's CAT's Ambulance service. Of these, two are Advanced Life Support ambulances and one Basic Life Support Ambulance. These will be delivered shortly.



Stitching affordable cotton masks for the needy

BRPL promoted Women Self Help Groups are stitching affordable & reusable masks for thousands of people residing in the slums of West Delhi. These three layered masks are helping these women supplement their loss of income during the pandemic. An alternate to commercial masks, these homemade masks made with 100% cotton also being distributed amongst the needy and vulnerable sections. In November, 3000 masks were distributed by BRPL.



Over 30,000 trees planted in BRPL' Tree Plantation Drive

BRPL' CSR programs continued to build on the annual tree-plantation drive that started in the July month. After planting around 28000 trees till October, around over 2000 trees were planted in November. Apart from the CRPF Camp, Jharonda Kalan in West Delhi, trees were also planted in the Delhi Government and MCD Schools.



Over 28,000 students to benefit from renovation of toilets in Govt schools

Issue of sanitation and hygiene has come into focus like never before because of Covid-19. Infact, they have become the virtues for safe and healthy living. In anticipation of schools opening in the weeks and months ahead, BRPL has been renovating toilets in government schools. In November alone, 30 toilets were renovated in 15 schools. These will benefit around 6000 students. Since April, 138 toilets from 67 schools have been renovated, which will benefit over 28200 when they will rejoin the school



Over 200 enrol in BRPL' vocational training centres

Adapting to the 'new normal, BRPL' Vocational Training Centres have also started online trainings apart from the traditional classes. Taking advantage of the online facility, many of the over 860 students enrolled in the career oriented training courses on Computers, Beauty and Tailoring are availing the virtual classes. Of these, 230 students enrolled in November itself. Apart from the curriculum, motivational classes and sanitation tips were also imparted for the participants.
