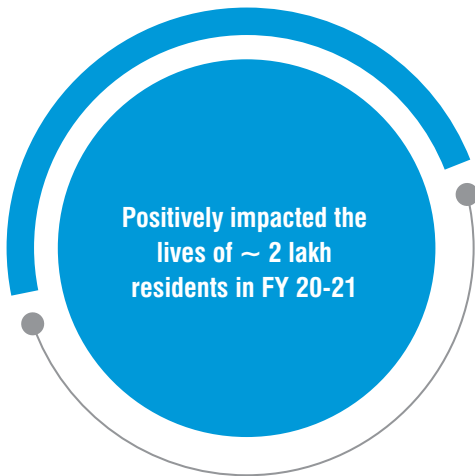


# SPARSH

Based on the track record of BRPL's Vocational Training Centres, students enrolled over 1100 students for undertaking job oriented courses on Computers, Beauty and Tailoring. The classes were undertaken by observing full Covid safety protocols and also organised in the virtual mode.

A 'Mega Job Fair' was organised at the two Vocational Training Centres (Mundka and Nilothi) for the job placement of the enrolled and eligible students. Several organisations, including Bajaj Capital, Om Innovations, Prerna Group, Innovesource, Hullet India Pvt and Get Works (for ICICI Bank) came for the recruitment. After interviews, 140 received placement offers, of salaries in excess of Rs 10,000. Of those selected, a large majority were women.
