Based on the track record of BRPL's Vocational Training Centres, students enrolled over 1100 students for undertaking job oriented courses on Computers, Beauty and Tailoring. The classes were undertaken by observing full Covid safety protocols and also organised in the virtual mode.

After interviews, 140 received placement offers, of salaries in excess of Rs 10.000. Of those selected, a large majority were women.
