Celebrating the World Environment Day, a tree plantation drive was undertaken wherein 1,600 trees and shrubs were planted. Additionally, BRPL's vocational training centers empowered underprivileged youth in fields like computers, beauty culture, fashion, and tailoring. Promoting financial literacy, women benefited from awareness programs and opening bank accounts. Furthermore, the capacity-building project for self-help groups engaged members, fostering social and economic empowerment. These initiatives demonstrate BRPL's commitment not only to reliable power supply but also to nurturing dreams, protecting the environment, and empowering communities.

Electrifying Dreams, Empowering Youth

At BRPL, we illuminate more than just homes - we light up dreams. Our vocational training centers are avenues for hundreds of needy youngsters to reach their aspirations. In June, approximately 25 enthusiastic students joined our centres to learn diverse skills ranging from Basic & Advanced Computing, Beauty Culture, to Fashion Design & Tailoring for a classroom based 6-months training program. As of June, a total of over 1200 students form the first batch of future changemakers.







Banking on Progress - Charging Up Financial Literacy

BRPL is more than a power supplier; we're a conduit for growth, particularly in promoting financial literacy among the needy. Through our committed CSR programs, we strive to enlighten our beneficiaries about financial principles, personal finance management, and money matters. Our initiative to open bank accounts for those who have been excluded from the formal banking system has been fruitful. In June, this initiative brightened the financial future for around 500 women, and the around 1500 women to date.





Powering Green Commitments, One Tree at a Time

BRPL doesn't just power homes; we fuel a sustainable future too. As part of our celebration of the World Environment Day on June 5th, we partnered with the Office of the District Magistrate, West to launch a tree plantation drive at Raja Garden. Shri Bhika Ram Meena, Additional District Magistrate, Shri Ashish Kumar, SDM Rajouri Garden, and senior officials from both the government and BSES were present on the occasion. They also took an oath to protect the environment. A total of around 1600 trees and shrubs were planted on the occasion. A total of 30,000 trees will be planted in the months ahead.
