At BRPL, Corporate Social Responsibility is guided by a simple belief – that progress must reach communities where it is needed most and create opportunities that endure.

During March, this commitment continued across South and West Delhi through initiatives focused on healthcare, women empowerment, livelihoods, youth development and community well-being. From safe drinking water and doorstep medical care to vocational training, financial literacy and support for women-led enterprises, each effort was designed to help communities move forward with greater confidence and dignity.

The month also witnessed improvements in community spaces and renewed encouragement for young sporting talent through the BSES Basketball Academy. Together, these initiatives reflect BRPL's continuing commitment to improving everyday life through practical support, meaningful engagement and inclusive growth.

Whether through healthcare, livelihoods, youth development or stronger community infrastructure, the purpose remains constant – to build stronger communities and brighter futures, one step at a time.

Drops of Care — Safe Drinking Water for All

Clean drinking water is one of the most basic yet important needs of any community. Keeping this in mind, BRPL has made three Water ATMs operational at MCD School A-5 Paschim Vihar, MCD Primary School I-Block Sangam Vihar and a community location near Jawalapuri.

These locations cater to children and families from varied socio-economic backgrounds, making access to safe and reliable drinking water especially important. The initiative is expected to benefit more than 6,000 people, helping improve health, comfort and overall well-being.



Threads of Trust — Handloom Livelihoods in Motion

BRPL's Handloom Incubation Units — Thread of Trust — at Sangam Vihar and Uttam Nagar continue to empower women through training and livelihood opportunities.

More than 100 women beneficiaries have enrolled in handloom machine operations and allied skills. Around 50 beneficiaries have also been linked with Udyam Aadhaar and registration certifications.

Products created by these women are being promoted across online platforms such as Amazon, Flipkart, JioMart, Meesho and others, helping expand their reach and income opportunities.

A special stall was also organised at State Emporium, Baba Kharag Singh Marg on 9 March, where the products were appreciated by visitors and helped showcase traditional craftsmanship.



Healing on Wheels — Healthcare That Reaches Doorsteps

Access to timely healthcare remains a challenge for many families. To bridge this gap, BRPL's Mobile Dispensary initiative is bringing health check-ups and medicine support directly to underserved communities, with special focus on women in South East and South Delhi.

During March, around 1,000 beneficiaries received support under the programme, taking the total outreach to nearly 6,000 people so far. By bringing healthcare closer to home, the initiative is helping communities receive timely care and better health support.



Courts of Aspiration — Encouraging Young Talent

BSES marked a special moment with a Hawan and Pooja ceremony at the newly developed high-performance Basketball Court in Sarita Vihar. BSES officials, coaches, academy members and young players participated in the event.

The upgraded facility strengthens the vision of the BSES Basketball Academy, which continues to support talented youngsters through structured coaching, modern infrastructure and opportunities to grow through sport.

It is another step towards nurturing discipline, confidence and dreams beyond the classroom.



Powering Dreams — Skills for a Better Tomorrow

BRPL not only powers homes and businesses — it also powers aspirations. Through its Vocational Training Centres, youth from underprivileged backgrounds are receiving skills that can help them build secure futures.

During FY 2025–26, around 2,000 students successfully completed courses across 11 centres in areas such as beauty services, tailoring and computer education. These centres continue to open doors to employment, self-reliance and brighter possibilities.



Stitching Dignity — Supporting Women's Health

BRPL continues to promote menstrual hygiene and dignity by manufacturing and distributing affordable sanitary napkins for women from underserved communities who often lack access to hygienic alternatives.

Made from safe, durable fabric layers, these napkins offer a practical and affordable solution. During March, 2,345 sanitary napkins were manufactured and 4,055 distributed. During the current financial year, close to 50,000 napkins have been stitched and distributed.

Beyond healthcare, the initiative also promotes awareness, confidence and dignity among women beneficiaries.



Money Matters — Building Financial Confidence

Financial awareness can transform lives. Through its CSR programmes, BRPL is helping underserved communities understand savings, budgeting, personal finance and the importance of joining the formal banking system.

During March, around 500 women benefited from the initiative, taking the total outreach to nearly 6,000 women during the financial year. The programme is helping families build stronger financial foundations and greater independence.



Together We Grow — Women Empowering Women

Self Help Groups supported by BRPL continue to create opportunities for women from weaker sections of society. These groups are helping women learn practical skills while also building confidence and financial independence.

Training programmes have included soft toy making, frock stitching, handicrafts, wall hangings, jhumars and bag making. During the financial year, around 240 women were enrolled across 24 Self Help Groups.

These groups are becoming strong platforms for livelihood creation and community support.



Spaces of Dignity — Improving Community Infrastructure

BRPL continues to support communities through the renovation and improvement of cremation grounds across multiple locations. During March, renovation work at three locations was successfully completed and the upgraded facilities are now fully functional.

The improvements included fresh whitewashing, covered wood storage areas, better seating arrangements and other essential civil works. These changes have helped create cleaner, more organised and respectful spaces for families during sensitive moments.
