## Illuminating Futures: BRPL Sparks Hope with Vocational Training

In May, around 114 students were enrolled in BRPL's vocational training centers, where they learned various skills such as Basic & Advance Computers, Beauty Culture, Fashion Designing & Tailoring. The classrooms became a hub of ambition and determination, as these youngsters from underprivileged backgrounds took a step closer to realizing their dreams. Till May, 1209 students have been enrolled so far in the 1st batch.



## Brightening Lives: BRPL Empowers the Needy with Financial Literacy

BRPL understands that true empowerment goes beyond just electricity. Through its CSR programs, it aims to spread awareness on financial concepts, personal finance, and the management of money. In May 2023, BRPL organized a drive that benefited around 500 women, providing them with the knowledge and tools to take control of their financial futures. This initiative has already enrolled a total of 1,000 women, setting them on a path towards financial independence.



## Empowering Women: BRPL Lights the Way with Self Help Groups

BRPL believes in the power of collective strength and empowerment. Through the Self Help Power Groups (SHGs), BRPL aims to uplift women from underprivileged sections of society, enhancing their social and economic status. In May 2023, 52 members actively participated in the capacity-building project in West Delhi, equipping themselves with essential skills for personal and professional growth. BRPL is committed to supporting these women and ensuring their journey towards a brighter future.
