Painted in partnership between BRPL and MCD as part of the discom's CSR program, the mural covers 1300 sq. feet of wall area and depicts Delhi's famous landmarks and the life in general.

During the month, two programs were organised in South Delhi that saw participation from 121 residents. Of these, 89 quit the habit.

BRPL's SHG's manufacture and distribute over 1 lakh sanitary pads and 15,000 masks

Continuing with its theme of hygiene, BRPL is striving to make homemade sanitary napkins and affordable masks accessible to the underprivileged sections. Stitched by BRPL's Self Help Groups, around 45760 sanitary napkins and around 3620 (3 ply) masks were stitched and distributed among the needlest in the month of Sep'22. Since April, 101348 sanitary napkins and around 15605 masks have been distributed.







Around 30,000 trees planted

Continuing with its tree plantation drive, BRPL planted 2675 trees at various locations (mainly in schools) in South and West Delhi in Sep'22. Since July, around 30000 trees have been planted in South and West Delhi.







BRPL's Yoga camps an equaliser between cops and students

For the well-being of our society, Seven Yoga camps were organised at various locations in South Delhi. Around 175 people – mainly students and Police personnel - benefitted from them in Sep'22. The participants were also trained-on simple exercises that they can do at their leisure for their well being. Around 648 people have been benefited so far since April 2022.
