From sterilizing and vaccinating thousands of stray animals to nurturing wellness through yoga and eye care camps; from planting thousands of trees that cleanse the city's air to distributing books that open young minds; from

producing sanitary napkins that preserve dignity to weaving livelihoods on handlooms — BRPL is powering positive change across every layer of society.

Each sapling, each stitch, each smile tells a story of progress. Together, they echo our enduring belief — we don't just power homes, we power humanity.

At BRPL, we believe power has many forms — the power to illuminate homes, the power to uplift communities, and the power to transform lives. Sparsh is our way of sharing these stories of light, love, and lasting change.

## Paws of Care: Managing Strays with Dignity

On Delhi's bustling streets, where humans and animals coexist every day, compassion often makes the biggest difference. Recognizing the need to ensure safety, health, and harmony, BSES is undertaking unique initiative to care for community animals through Animal Birth Control (ABC) and Anti-Rabies Vaccination (ARV) drives.

In alignment with the Animal Birth Control Rules, 2023, and the National Action Plan for Rabies Elimination (NAPRE) 2030, the program seeks to

sterilize and vaccinate 10,000 stray dogs and 1,000 cats — promoting humane population management and preventing rabies. Sterilized animals are identified through ear notching and microchipping, with detailed digital records maintained for transparency and monitoring.

So far, over 8,250 dogs and nearly 1000 cats have been vaccinated and sterilized — each one representing a step toward safer streets, healthier animals, and a more compassionate city.











#### Vision of Care: Eye Camps That See Beyond Sight

Good vision leads to a brighter future — literally. As part of its CSR initiatives, BSES has been conducting health and eye care camps across its areas to make quality healthcare easily accessible to the community. Continuing this endeavour, today BSES, in association with Sagar Trust and Ayushman Arogya Mandir, organized a Free Eye and Health Camp at the Delhi Government Dispensary Building, Begumpur, Malviya Nagar.

The camp was inaugurated by Hon'ble Shri Satish Upadhyay, MLA Malviya Nagar, and witnessed enthusiastic participation from local residents. Hundreds benefitted from free eye check-ups,



medical consultations, and the distribution of medicines and spectacles.

Through such initiatives, BSES is proud to light up lives, strengthen community well-being, and bring vision – both literally and figuratively – to the people of Delhi.







#### **Breathe Easy: Trees That Power Delhi's Tomorrow**

In a rapidly urbanizing Delhi, trees are our green guardians — cleansing the air, cooling our surroundings, and sustaining life. In September, BRPL planted around 6,000 trees and shrubs across West Delhi — in schools, community centres, BSF and CRPF camps, and other public spaces. With this, the total plantation in FY 2025–26 has reached an impressive 47,000. Each sapling is not just a tree, but a living promise for cleaner air and a greener tomorrow.







#### Stretching for Strength: Yoga for Every Body

BRPL continues to promote holistic well-being through its Yoga for Health initiative. This September, 17 yoga camps were conducted across schools and police establishments, benefiting around 510 participants — including students, teaching and non-teaching staff, and police personnel. Participants also learned simple exercises they can practice in their leisure time for sustained wellness. Till date, 20 camps have reached over 600 individuals, helping them breathe, stretch, and smile their way to better health.







#### **Books of Hope: Turning Pages, Shaping Futures**

Education is the most powerful tool of empowerment. BRPL, in association with Anmol Educational and Social Welfare Society, distributed books and stationery to 225 underprivileged children (Nursery to Class VII) in Kharak, Chhatarpur, Mehrauli. Each book distributed is a step toward a brighter, more informed, and empowered generation — because every page turned is a life transformed.









#### Threads of Empowerment: Handloom Units Weaving Livelihoods

The 'Thread of Trust' Handloom Incubation Units at Sangam Vihar and Uttam Nagar continue to empower women through skill development and entrepreneurship. Over 100 women artisans are being trained in handloom weaving and allied operations.

By September, 18 beneficiaries were registered under Udyam Aadhaar and issued certificates, linking them to formal markets. BRPL's NGO partner SAVE showcased these handcrafted creations at Chanakyapuri RWA's Navratri Mela — where dignitaries lauded the artisans' craftsmanship. Our handloom creations are now available on leading online platforms like Amazon, JioMart, Snapdeal, Meesho, and IndiaHandmade, expanding their reach from local looms to global rooms.













#### Dignity in Every Stitch: Sanitary Napkins for Women's Health

BRPL's initiative to manufacture and distribute affordable sanitary napkins is empowering women from slum communities with health, hygiene, and dignity. These ecofriendly napkins, made from 100% pure, tightly woven fabric, are a safer alternative to commercial products.

In September, 10,000 sanitary napkins were produced and distributed — taking the cumulative total to 17,200 manufactured and distributed so far. With every stitch, we are shaping healthier and more confident lives.







### **Powering Potential: Vocational Training That Transforms Lives**

BRPL's Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) continue to empower underprivileged youth and women with employable skills in tailoring, beauty, and computer education. In September alone, 100 new students were enrolled, taking the total enrolment across 10 centres to over 1,050 students so far. These centres also include specialized programs for the visually impaired and differently abled, ensuring inclusivity in learning and livelihood. Every skill learned is a spark of self-reliance — lighting up pathways to a brighter tomorrow.

## **Counting Change: Powering Financial Literacy**

Empowerment begins with awareness. BRPL's Financial Literacy Drive helps women from underprivileged communities understand personal finance, banking, and money management. In September, 500 women benefitted from the sessions, taking the total to 3,000 women this year — many opening their first-ever bank accounts and joining the formal financial system.







## Strength in Circles: Building Capacity through SHGs

BRPL's Self-Help Groups (SHGs) are driving social and economic empowerment among women by promoting skill development and micro-entrepreneurship. In September, 30 women joined 3 new SHGs, learning to create soft toys, frocks, handicrafts, jhumars, wall hangings, and bags. Till date, 17 SHGs with around 170 women are active — each group a shining example of unity, creativity, and empowerment in action.
