	We find this criterion to be somewhat unusual for a utility-scale empanelment, particularly when the scope of work typically involves capacities starting from 4 MW upwards. Requiring a minimum of 50 installations totalling only 2 MWp appears is only to favour smaller rooftop vendors rather than experienced utility-scale EPC players.	
	It is our suggestion that BSES may wish to consider criteria that reflect the capabilities of vendors with proven experience in utility-scale solar projects—such as having executed one or two projects of at least 5 MWp each in the last three years. We believe this would result in the empanelment of more robust and resourceful vendors capable of delivering high-quality projects.
