

Delhi's Transport Minister Lays Foundation of BRPL 66/11 kV Grid in West Delhi

Delhi's Revenue & Transport Minister, Shri Kailash Gahlot laid the foundation stone for BRPL state-of-the-art 700/800 kV Grid at Village Mitraon in Najafgargh yesterday. Others present on the occasion included senior BRPL officials, led by the CEO Shri Amal Sinha.

Being constructed in 2 phases, the 1st phase of 20 MVA will be commissioned in a record time of 3-months & the 2nd phase of additional 40 MVA, thereafter. When completed, this grid will benefit around 1.5 lakh residents of Delhi's fast developing Western suburb of Najafgargh. The present network capacity in the area is 80 MVA. Post complete commissioning of the grid, it will increase by 60 MVA to 140 MVA – enough to power the present and the future needs of the area.
