

...enlightening lives

During FY 2015-2016, a series of well thought through outreach activities were undertaken in targeted areas of South and West Delhi as part of RPL'CSR. This issue of Sparsh gives a round-up of these activities.

These activities have positively touched the lives of around 1 lakh people.



Adult Literacy Program: Around 9,000 women - from lower income groups - imparted functional literacy in 120 Centres in South and West Delhi



Sanitation Drive: Awareness and sanitation drive undertaken in 100 MCD schools of South and West Delhi along with a NGO. Toilets repaired and spruced-up in 40 schools so far



Nukkad Nataks: Over 60 plays staged to educate people about the menace of power theft, safety and energy conservation



Project Dignity: Improved the conditions of Lodhi Crematorium and Pet Crematorium - 'Paws to Heaven'



Green Project: Over 7.4 tonnes of waste paper collected from various divisions, stores and others offices for recycling into over 18000 notepads/ paper rims



Bill Distribution in JJ Clusters: Women from BRPL' Adult Literacy Centres are helping in bill distribution & collection of arrears from defaulters in JJ Clusters of Tagore Garden & Nangloi



Electrician Training Program: 325, mainly RWA nominated electricians, imparted training



Blood Donation Camps: Over 175 employees donated blood in seven camps



Eye and Medical Camps: Over 7500 residents examined and over 5500 glasses distributed in 20 eye and medical camps



Energy Program: Promoted energy conservation to over 50,000 students in over 150 schools



Self Defence Trainings: Around 1200 school girls imparted training in 12 schools and colleges



Cancer Detection Camps: Around 400 residents (including women) examined in four camps



Community Sports: - Around 1200 players (women - 330) from over 100 teams (women - 30) participated in Kabaddi and Volleyball talents contests



Vocational Training: Four vocational centres started lin association with a NGO) to impart trainings on various disciplines including Computers, Beauty Culture, Tailoring and Retail Management



Earth Hour: Promoted Earth Hour. 207 MW saved in BSES' area (BRPL 130 MW)
