BRPL' CSR Rankings



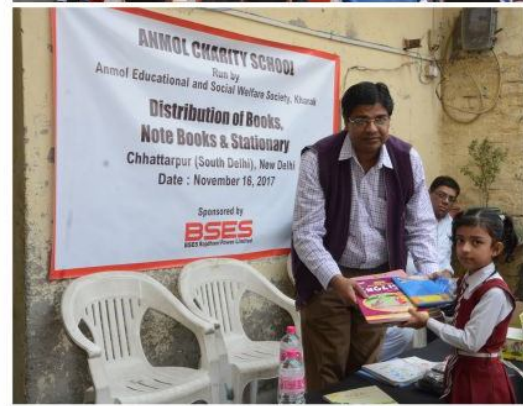
Sixty toilets renovated in govt schools

BRPL, in an association with Sahyog Care for You, undertook a campaign for repairing and sprucing-up of toilets in government schools. The campaign was undertaken in around 30 schools, where 60 toilets were renovated. After repairing, experts also demonstrated habits of good hygiene and sanitation to the students.



Books distributed to 225 under privileged students

During the month, BRPL also organised a book distribution program in association with Anmol Educational and Social Welfare Society in Chattarpur, Mehrauli. Books and stationary were distributed to 225 underprivileged children, studying in classes' nursery to seventh.

BRPL organised three tobacco de-addiction camps in outer West Delhi area, where over 230 people visited. Out of these, 194 quit the habit of smoking and chewing tobacco.

Energy Conservation in Schools

BRPL conducted energy conservation programs in Najafgarh and Jaffarpur divisions, where around 880 students from nine schools participated. In these workshops, students not only learned on how to conserve electricity but also participated in rallies to promote energy conservation.



Other Activities

- Eye Care Camps: Over 450 residents visited the free eye check-up camp organised at Hanuman Mandir Choupal, Village Dichaon, in the Najafgarh. After examination, around 250 glasses and 230 medicines were distributed.
- Self Defence Training: Self defence training was organised in two-schools, where around 150 girls were taught the art of self defence.
- Vocational Training: Certificates were distributed to over 572 students who completed their six months course in our four centres situated in Mundka, Nangloi, Jaffarour and Najafgarh.
