## **Tree Plantation Drive to reduce Co2**

Doing its bit for the environment, BRPL has planted 15000 trees in the last two month in West Delhi. Of these, over 12000 samplings, best suited for Delhi's climate, were planted in September itself. These 15,000 trees are estimated to reduce carbon dioxide by around 7.2 lakh pounds every year.

In addition to these, Adult Literacy (ALC) and Vocational Training (VT) are continuing at a steady pace. In the first six months of FY 2017-2018, around 1350 have benefitted from the ALC and around 600 from the VT.



## Residents sight is in BRPL' vision

A free eye check-up camp was successfully organized at Shiv Mandir, "Z" Block, Gopal Nagar, Jaffarpur. Around 400 residents visited the camp, where around 230 glasses and 270 medicines were distributed.
