Awareness program "Safety from Electrical Accidents" marches on





Organised in association with ACORDASIA, awareness programs on "Safety from Electrical Accidents" was organised in two more schools during the month. Around 180 students from South Delhi Nigam Pratibha Vidyalaya, Okhla (Girls) and M.C.Boys Primary School, Jamia Nagar,Okhla participated in these programs.

Apart from these, a focused group discussion with women's' community group was also conducted in a phased manner. Around 50 women participated in this event. Apart from this, four safety awareness camps were organised in the Jasola Village, where nearly 200 people actively participated.
