Green Grid to 'power' Commonwealth Games 2010



In the run up to the Commonwealth Games 2010, BSES is setting up a 66/11 kV Grid Sub Station in the vicinity of the picturesque Akshardham temple. The foundation stone for this state-

of-the-art Grid station was laid by Smt Sheila Dikshit, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi on January 17, 2009 in the presence of Olympian Gurbachan Singh Randhawa.

This Rs 40 crore state-of-the-art 25 MVA 'Commonwealth' Grid will exclusively cater to the electricity requirements of the upcoming Commonwealth Games Complex. The Grid is expected to be completed before March 2010. It would also be Delhi's first Green Grid. Over 30 percent of the total Grid area will have green cover. BSES also plans to take care of the softer elements of the Grid including aesthetics and landscaping.
