# Now simply enter your CRN Number to register 'No Supply' complaint

You are no longer in a queue. All BRPL customers in South and West Delhi can register their "no supply" complaints directly. You need to just call the state-ofthe-art call centre number - 39999707 - and simply enter your 10-digit CRN number, as printed on your bill.

Not only will the complaint be immediately registered in real time and the query sent directly to the concerned complaint centre for faster resolution, but you will also be given an instant acknowledgement number. For your convenience, this automatic acknowledgement number can be replayed.

Procedure to register a power outage complaint on IVRS

Step 1- Dial 399/99707

Step 2 - Choose Language (English / Hindi)

Step 3 - Press 1 for registering no supply complaint

Step 4 - Press 1 to enter your 10-digit CRN Number

**Bill and Payment Details** 


Now you can get your Bill and Payment details by simply sending a SMS. You just need to SMS your CRN number to 5-545-464 and immediately, you will receive the requisite details. All you have to do is:

Type BSES <SPACE> BILL <SPACE> CRN Number and SMS to 5545464

Initially both the services are for single phase customers, comprising a bulk of the company's over 14 lakh customers.
