BRPL and BYPL have separately signed a 25-year MoU to procure 25 MW of solar power each with ACME Jaisalmer Solar Pvt Ltd. recently.

Through this agreement, BSES companies became the first power distribution

companies in India to take the lead in showing commitment to the Jawahar Lal Nehru National Solar Mission (JNNSM) - an ambitious project for generating 20,000 MW of Grid Solar Power by 2020 - launched by Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh.

ACME Group is setting up three solar plants, of 50 MW's each in Rajasthan (Jaisalmer, Bikaner and Jodhpur). BRPL and BYPL will procure the entire 50 MW (25 MW each) from the Rs 750 crore Jaisalmer Solar Thermal Power Plant expected to be commissioned by June 2011.

BRPL' 'Green' Lok Adalat settles 1727 cases and saves 27,000 A4 papers

In an effort to fast-track disposal of power theft cases, BRPL in association with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee, organized a two-day 'green' Lok Adalat for its customers in South and West Delhi on Feb 13 and 14. The paperless Lok Adalat created history by settling 1727 or 96% of the power theft cases on the spot, its highest ever at a single Lok Adalat. It also managed to save nearly 27,000 A 4 size papers, or nearly four full grown trees.

Meanwhile, BRPL has also signed a 25 year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Timarpur-Okhla Waste Management Company Private Limited (TOWMCL) to buy electricity from Delhi's largest 'city waste to power' initiative, being set up at Okhla.

BRPL will procure 50% of the exportable electricity that will be generated by the 16 MW 'waste to energy' integrated power plant in Okhla.

The project, awarded to TOWMCL will process over 643,500 lakh metric tonnes or one third of Delhi's Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) per year generated in Delhi. The plant expected to be commissioned by early 2011, is expected to annually lead to emission reductions of 266,066 metric tonnes of CO2 equivalent.
