of the trade fair IITF at Pragati Maidan between November 14-27, 2017. Due to the ban on diesel genets in Delhi by EPCA, the entire event was powered solely by the grid-power supplied by the discom. BRPL' team worked round the clock to gear-up its system and energised a temporary connection of 3 MW in a record time. Working closely with ITPO, BRPL lived-up to the challenge and ensured uninterrupted and reliable power supply during the 14 day event.
