



BRPL's CSR programs maintain a symbiotic relationship with the community. The Covid pandemic notwithstanding, BRPL's CSR programs have been playing their part in making a positive impact on the lives of the needy. They continue to reach-out to the under privileged.

Since onset of the Covid, the programs have evolved, adapting to the 'new normal' under its 'Sparsh' initiative. For maximising the benefits to the intended beneficiaries, the CSR programs are working in close coordination with the authorities to identify the need gaps and implement the possible solutions. During the month of August, the focus of the CSR programs was on Vocational Training, Manufacturing and distribution of Masks and Sanitary Napkins and Tree Plantation.

BRPL Self Help Groups stitch and distribute sanitary napkins and masks to the needy

BRPL is striving to make homemade and affordable masks accessible to the underprivileged sections, who have to move out in the community and yet, cannot afford them. A reliable alternative to commercial face masks, these cloth masks have three layers of tightly woven 100 percent cotton fabric, such as quilter's material with a high thread count. Stitched by BRPL's Self Help Groups, around 1000 sanitary napkins and 500 masks were stitched and distributed among the neediest in the month of August. Since April, around 13000 sanitary napkins and 3500 mask have been distributed till August.



Vocational Training Centers' enrol new students

Adapting to the 'new normal', BRPL's Vocational Training Centres are conducting online trainings apart from the traditional classes on the job oriented courses on Computers, Beauty Culture and Tailoring. The classes are being undertaken by observing full Covid safety protocols. Adding to the tally of 550 students who had enrolled in July for the new batch, 232 students enrolled in August 2021, taking the total count to 782 students.

Taking advantage of the weather, over 2600 saplings planted in August
