



After planting over 5000 trees in July, we planted nearly 6000 trees in August. Apart from tree plantation, camps on eye care, energy conservation and women empowerment were organised during the month. Renovation and repairing of toilets was also undertaken in Government schools.

Around 100 women enrol in new Vocational Training Centre

To equip young women with skills for gaining meaningful employment, BRPL has launched another Vocational Training Centre (VTC). Being 5th in BRPL' area and 2nd in Jaffarpur, this Centre has already enrolled 98 women – taking the total number of enrolled students to nearly 700.



Over 12000 trees planted

Under BRPL' ongoing tree plantation drive, around 6000 saplings were planted during August, taking the count to over 12000 in just two-months. They were planted in 16 locations, including school premises and societies. Last year, we had planted 15,000 trees.



Over 1500 sensitised on energy conservation and power theft

Organised in association with the Alkhaddim Foundation, around 200 residents participated in an awareness program on energy conservation and power theft at Ghaffar Manzil Ext near Haji Colony. Apart from this, workshops on energy conservation reached out to 1385 students in 13 MCD schools.



Over 3500 students sensitised on hygiene and toilets renovated

BRPL, in an association with Sahyog Care for You, undertook a campaign for repairing and sprucing-up of toilets in government schools. During the month, six toilets in 3 MCD schools were renovated and 3586 students sensitised on sanitation and hygiene.



Apart from these programs, around 1400 residents took advantage of the five, free eye care camps organised at their doorstep in Najafgarh and Jaffarpur divisions. After examination by ophthalmologists, over 900 glasses and medicines were distributed.
