Nearly 1200 attend eye care camps

Three free eye check-up camps were successfully organised in West Delhi, where nearly 1200 area residents participated. Over 760 glasses and 720 medicines were also distributed at these camps. Of these camps, two were organised in the Jaffarpur division and one in the Najafgarh division.

Around 2000 students take the green pledge

Around 2000 students from 13 schools in Najafgarh, Nangloi and Mundka participated in the energy conservation workshops. Besides being addressed by experts on the subject, they undertook energy conservation rallies to make the communities aware about the subject. They also took the green pledge.



Fifty toilets in 25 schools renovated

BRPL' program to renovate toilets in government schools is going ahead full steam. During the month, 50 toilets in 25 schools were repaired and whitewashed in Najafgarh, Nangloi and Mundka. Subsequently, our experts demonstrated correct hand washing techniques and gave gyan on sanitation to over 2500 school children.



BRPL' self defence training gives confidence to around 100 girls

BRPL' self defence training program gave confidence to 99 school girls in Najafgarh. These girls, all students of the New Krishna Public Sr. Secondary School, participated in the week long program on the various self defence techniques. They were given a school bag and a certificate each at the end of the training program.
