



BRPL' CSR activities continue to positively impact various sections of our society. During June, these activities further built on the momentum achieved in the previous months. Women empowerment and environment, cornerstone of our activities, are both important, not only to our CSR programs, but are also intrinsic to what we stand for as an organisation.

BRPL' CSR Trivia

In around four years, BRPL' CSR programs have directly benefitted nearly 40,000 women through several women centric programs. This figure substantially increases when we include, women participation in gender neutral activities like eye and tobacco de addiction camps.

With an aim to empower women, BRPL has started several initiatives with Cequin (Centre For Equity and Inclusion), our NGO partner, in targeted areas of South Delhi, including Joga Bai, JogaBai, Zakir Nagar, Noor Nagar, Haji Colony, Okhla Vihar, Dhobi Ghat, Batla House, Azeem Dairy in Jamia Nagar. Besides just empowering women, the program also tries to enlist men and boys from the community on issues of gender sensitization. During the last few weeks, over 4500 residents have benefited these from these activities undertaken in six broad categories, including:

- (i) Social Responsibility of development of Women and Girls;
- (ii) Community Based Collectives;
- (iii) Education of women;
- (iv) Generating awareness of health and wellbeing;
- (v) Skill Development,
- (vi) Activities with Men and Boys (on gender sensitisation among others)

BRPL cares for the environment and like Delhi's residents; it too is concerned about the incidence of growing pollution. Doing its bit, BRPL routinely plants trees in its licensed area. Last year alone, it planted 15000 saplings – meeting its mandated target for the year. To mark, the World Environment Day on June 5 this year, 100 saplings were planted at Sarvoyda Vidaylaya, Peergarhi Village in West Delhi.
