



At over 30,000, the month of October saw our CSR activities reach-out to a record number of beneficiaries. These programs ranged across several activities, including Self Defence Training for Girls, Eye Care and Tobacco Deaddiction camps, Energy Conservations, Renovation of Toilets, Adult Literacy and Vocational Training.

Smoking for 81% men and women goes-up in smoke

Our anti-tobacco de-addiction program continued its march in October. Of the 190 people that participated in our two camps conducted in association Dr. Sajeela Maini, a renowned doctor from Sir Gangaram Hospital, a whopping 81% (154) kicked the butt.





900 enrol in 30 Adult Literacy Centers

The women trained at our Adult Literacy Centres are proving to be an inspiration for their ilk. Motivated by them, around 900 women from the poorer sections of our society and residing in slums /JJ clusters enrolled at our Adult Literacy programs at 30 centres.





240 girls get self confidence booster

Our self defence training, organised in association with a SPG Commando, gave confidence to 750 girl students from three West Delhi schools.



68 toilets renovated in 34 schools

BRPL in association with NGO partner renovated 68 toilets in 34 MCD schools, benefitting over 25,000 students. As part of the program, these students were also sensitised on personal hygiene.





750 get clear vision at free eye care camps

Three eye care camps organised in Najafgarh division gave a clear vision to around 750 residents who were also distributed free medicines and glasses.





Energy Conservation program gets 3500 converts

Our energy conservation campaign got 3500 fresh recruits during the month. Of these, 3156 came from the 13 MCD schools and around 300 from the Jhuggis near N block Batla House.



2991 women empowered

(Ongoing Program-1 April 2018 onwards)
Around 3000 women participated in various programs to empower them in areas in and around Joga Bai, JogaBai, Zakir Nagar, Noor Nagar, Haji Colony, Okhla Vihar, Dhobi Ghat, Batla House, Azeem Dairy in Jamia Nagar. Organised in association with Cequin (Centre For Equity and Inclusion), the program also enlisted men (and boys) from the community on issues of gender sensitization.



750 students enrol in 5 Vocational Training Centres

Around 750 students enrolled at our five vocational training centres at Nangloi, Najafgarh, Jafarpur and Mundka. Depending on their preference, they will get trainings skills such as computers (Basic and Advanced), Beauty Culture, Tailoring and Retail Management.
