## BRPL partners with Bank of Baroda for payment of electricity bills

## Consumer offerings like co branded debit cards & online payments are under consideration

Soon this partnership with BoB will also be extended to BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL)

Consumer's account will be updated on the same day, the payment has been made. Consumers will be able to pay their electricity bills at BoB branches through Cash (upto Rs 4000/-, as per Hon'ble DERC guidelines), Cheque and DD. BoB account holders will be able to pay by way of fund transfer.

This is the second such initiative undertaken by BRPL. Earlier, the company had entered into a similar arrangement with IDBI Bank. Soon this partnership with BoB will also be extended to BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL).

According to Mr Amal Sinha, CEO, BRPL, "This partnership between BSES and Bank of Baroda will go a long way. I am sure, both the organizations, leaders in their respective spheres, will be able to draw on and leverage each other's strengths"

"We are also exploring that in the weeks and months ahead on how to extend the portfolio of offerings for our consumers under this partnership. Among the offering under consideration are offering cobranded debit cards and online payments, added Mr Sinha
