Do you know, air conditioning can account for 30-50% of a company's / household's annual energy costs? Increasing the air-conditioner setting by just 1 degree Celsius can save around 6% electricity. Therefore, for the most comfort at the least cost, set your AC thermostat between 24-25 degree Celsius.
