SURAKSHA empowers 92 students through Self Defence training

BYPL organised 19 free health camps with NGO partners PHD Rural Development Foundation & Sofia Educational and Welfare Society. Over 2527 people benefited from the free medical consultations and free medicines.

In November, BYPL organised 10 eye camps with NGO partner Ishwar Charitable Trust (unit of I-Care Hospital, Noida) and reached out to 4039 people. In all, 2663 reading glasses and 2187 eye drops were provided free to the beneficiaries.







SURAKSHA safety awareness programme for Mahila Shiksha Kendra instructors
