BSES Provides 850 e Tablets To Students Of Delhi Government Schools

Delhi's Deputy Chief Minister hands-over e-tablets to students

BSES CSR programs have been making a positive impact in the lives of citizens of Delhi. Over the last few years, the programs have reached-out to over 6.5 lakh beneficiaries in South, West, East and Central Delhi. As part of its efforts to help the needy during the Covid-10, BSES discoms are providing Dry food rations, Hygiene kits and masks. Infact, over the past few months, over 3 lakh gloves, 2 lakh masks, over 20,000 hygiene kits, and 7500 PPE kits have been provided by BSES discoms.
