Heaters and geysers take Delhi's peak (winter) power demand to an all-time high of 5343 MW

January 1, 2020 was truly a momentous day. It not only marked the beginning of a new year, a new decade, but also saw Delhi's peak winter power demand reaching 5343 MW – its highest ever. It broke the previous high of 5298 MW recorded on December 30, 2019. This is an increase of over 19% from the peak power demand of 4472 MW, recorded on January 1, 2019.

load (Heaters and Geysers) is the main factor behind the increase in Delhi's power load winter months. Infact, according to estimates, over 40% of Delhi's power demand in winters is because of the heating load.
