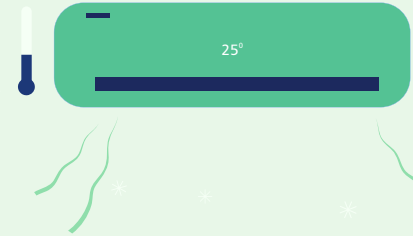
You can use your Debit / Credit Card to pay electricity bills in upto 24 months

Easy steps:

- Visit the BYPL website (www.bsesdelhi.com)
- Enter the CA no to fetch the bill amount detail
- Proceed for payment – Click on the 'Pay Now' option
- Web page redirected to the 'Bill Desk' page
- Payment options like Credit Card, Debit Card, EMI, Net Banking etc appear
- Choose the EMI option - a list of banks appears
- Select the bank and the EMI plan
- Follow the steps and pay your bill



Simple AC tips to help you conserve energy and save money during summers



Air conditioning can account for 30-50% of a company's/ household's annual energy costs. Simple and easy to follow tips will go a long-way in substantially reducing your electricity bill.

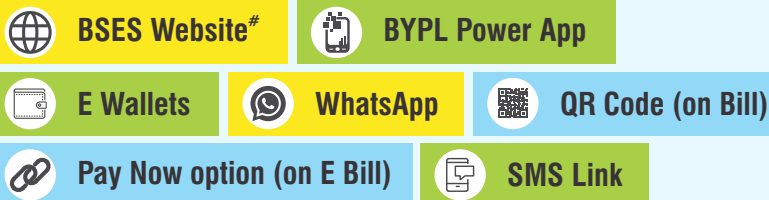
- For the most comfort at the least cost, set your AC thermostat at 25 degree C
- Keep the doors of the air-conditioned room closed as far as possible
- Clean the AC filter every month
- Using ceiling fans alongside the AC will circulate the air and reduce the load on the AC
- Line windows (and walls) with plants and install curtains in the room to block sunlight and insulate the room from heat
- Cool roofs (painting the roofs white or installing white tiles) on commercial and residential roofing can cut air conditioning costs
- Check the energy rating of electric appliances before you buy them. Higher the ratings, higher the savings.

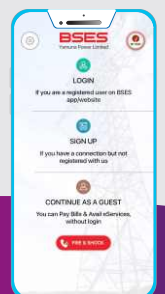
