## BYPL Honoured with CIDC Vishwakarma Award 2026

BYPL has been honoured with the CIDC (Construction Industry Development Council) Vishwakarma Award 2026, instituted by NITI Aayog, under the category of 'Creating Social Development and Impact'. The award recognised BYPL's efforts in promoting STEM education among Delhi Government school students, encouraging innovation, scientific learning, and skill development among young learners.



## Healthcare Initiative Promotes Post-Menopausal Well-being

As part of the BSES Seniors' Abode project, a healthcare session on post-menopausal health was conducted to raise awareness and empower women with knowledge about hormonal changes, bone health, emotional well-being, and preventive care.



## STEM Initiative Sees Enthusiastic Student Participation

Under the STEM initiative, BSES Yamuna Power Limited organised an inter-school competition to encourage students to apply their scientific knowledge and creativity through hands-on activities. The programme witnessed participation from 61 schools, engaging nearly 3,200 students during the Intra-School Rounds conducted in March and April.

Building on this momentum, 51 schools and 302 students advanced to the Cluster Round held in April across three categories—Quiz, Model Making, and Tinker Experiments. The rounds provided a platform for students to showcase their knowledge, innovation, and problem-solving skills, with top teams shortlisted for the Grand Finale in May.



## Army Veterans Complete Skill Training Programme

As part of the Army Veterans Skill Training Programme, two batches of veterans completed specialised training in Solar Technology and Drone Pilot Operations. A total of 28 veterans graduated from the Solar Technology course, while 20 veterans completed the Drone Pilot Operations program. The training equipped them with technical skills, expanding their prospects for sustainable livelihoods and career growth.



## BSES Academy Players Selected for U-14 Delhi Championship

The BSES Basketball Academy organised a Coaches Clinic at the High Performance Centre, led by Mr. Max Gvozdenovic, an England Basketball Level 3 Coach. The session provided coaches with exposure to advanced coaching techniques, practical drills, and interactive learning aimed at enhancing player development and game strategy. Nineteen students from the Basketball Academy have been selected to represent different districts of Delhi in the Under-14 Delhi Basketball Championship.



## Vocational Training Programme Launched for Youth Employability

BYPL, in partnership with the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), has launched a vocational skill training initiative at Madhu Vihar to enhance youth employability and create sustainable livelihood opportunities. The program offers industry-relevant courses in Food Product Handling, Digital Marketing, and Garment Making, with 240 students currently enrolled and undergoing training.
