## BYPL mega tree plantation drive at Delhi Police Academy

## BYPL CSR supports flood affected families

The flood situation in Yamuna has been a cause of concern for over 23,000 people losing their homes and livelihood. In these trying times, BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) under its CSR initiative provided 72,000 freshly cooked meals to 2000 displaced people in around 10 relief camps under SDM Seelampur and SDM Karawal Nagar in North East Delhi. The food was distributed for 12 days from 15 to 26 July 2023 to support these people in their hour of need.

Additionally as per the requirements received from the DM North East office, relief packets containing 4 soaps, 4 toothbrushes, toothpaste, odomos cream, milk powder etc. were distributed to 800 families in the relief camps.

# BYPL first company to take up Cool Roof Cool Delhi project under CSR for public buildings

BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) commences a first-of-its-kind energy efficient "Cool Roof Cool Delhi" project in Delhi under its CSR Srishti initiative. With this initiative BYPL becomes the first company to take up white roof projects under CSR for roof tops of public buildings. By painting many large roof areas white in an urban environment it helps to fight against the urban island heat effect. This is when cities suffer from much higher temperatures as the heat is contained by tall buildings and large amounts of asphalt. Cooling down bigger buildings can help reduce the overall temperature of a city or town.

**Maharaja Agrasen College (University of Delhi)** & the women hostel at the college was the first site chosen for painting white the 40,000 sq feet roof top area.

As part of this inclusive initiative **Asha Daan** Missionaries of Charity shelter for women with mental disability with 4,000 sq feet roof top area was also painted white.

A walk-through of the roof top was conducted at the Maharaja Agrasen College in presence of Vasundhara Enclave division team and Dr Sanjeev Kumar Tiwari, College Principal, staff and students. Similarly, a walk-through was undertaken at **Asha Daan** by women colleagues from various departments from BYPL.

Under its CSR initiative, BYPL is getting the roof tops painted white with certified **Green Rating for Integrated Habitat Assessment (GRIHA) & Indian Green Building Council (IGBC)** white reflective paint. This special paint helps to keep the building cool and as it reflects most of the sunlight back into the atmosphere it also helps to keep the surroundings cool.
