August 2025 was truly special for all of us at BYPL. It was a month filled with milestones that celebrated compassion, care and community.

BYPL continued to make a positive impact through diverse CSR initiatives. A two-week Solar PV Installation Program in Ambala equipped 19 army veterans with practical skills in renewable energy. At Seniors' Abode, residents benefited from a fire safety training session by Delhi Fire Services and showcased

their talents through a Raksha Bandhan exhibition-cum-sale generating ₹20,000. Under Dhaga Vishwas Ka, women artisans participated in a successful exhibition at Pragati Maidan on National Handloom Day, drawing over 85 visitors. The BSES Basketball Academy engaged 379 students across centres, celebrated International Youth Day with a quiz and 3x3 matches, and marked achievements with players selected for state-level championships and school teams excelling in zonal tournaments.

BSES Trains Veterans for Solar PV Installation

As part of our ongoing skill training initiative for army veterans, a two-week Solar PV Installation Program was launched in Ambala, where 19 veterans were trained to gain practical skills and career guidance in the renewable energy sector. The program includes solar fundamentals, installation, safety, maintenance, and hands-on exposure through practical sessions and a site visit to a 110 kW solar plant.

Till date, we have successfully completed 4 batches of Drone Pilot Training and 3 batches of Solar PV Installation Training, with the latest batch recently concluded.





Safety Meets Celebration at BSES Seniors' Abode

As part of its commitment to the safety and well-being of senior citizens, a fire safety training session was conducted at BSES Seniors' Abode by Delhi Fire Services with support from the BYPL Safety Department. A total of 50 residents and staff members actively participated, gaining hands-on experience and confidence to handle emergencies. The session covered fire safety awareness and a mock drill on evacuation, extinguisher use, and quick response.

On the occasion of Raksha Bandhan, BSES Seniors' Abode organized an exhibition-cum-sale of handcrafted products by senior citizens. The initiative generated sales of ₹20,000 by engaging BYPL employees, offering residents encouragement, recognition, and meaningful opportunities for interaction.







BSES Showcases Dhaga Vishwas Ka at Pragati Maidan

As part of its CSR initiative Dhaga Vishwas Ka, BSES celebrated National Handloom Day by organizing an exhibition-cum-sale at the National Crafts Museum & Hastkala Academy, Pragati Maidan. The stall, featuring handwoven products by women artisans from Uttam Nagar, drew over 85 visitors and generated sales of more than ₹18,000. The occasion was further enriched by the visit of noted designer Shri Shashank, the Handloom Hackathon awardee, whose insights and encouragement inspired the artisans and paved the way for potential collaborations.





BSES Academy Secures CBSE Zonal 2nd Spot

The BSES Basketball Academy engaged 379 students across its training centres in IP Extension and Begumpur. To mark International Youth Day, the IP Extension centre hosted a basketball quiz and exciting 3x3 matches. The Academy also celebrated significant milestones, with three players—two from East Delhi and one from South Delhi—selected to represent their districts at the Delhi State Sub Junior Basketball Championship 2025. Adding to the achievements, the Begumpur Government School team secured second place in the CBSE Under-17 Boys Zonal Tournament, reflecting the Academy's growing impact in nurturing young talent.
