Empowering Young Minds Through Atal Tinkering Labs

In collaboration with the Department of Education, Government of Delhi, and NITI Aayog, BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) inaugurated Atal Tinkering Labs in seven Delhi government schools, opening new avenues for over 2,000 students to engage with innovation, robotics, and emerging technologies. Equipped with robotics kits and digital fabrication tools, these labs will strengthen STEM education by providing hands-on learning opportunities that nurture creativity, critical thinking, and real-world problem-solving skills among young learners.



Empowering Graduates with Sashakt Scholarships

This month, 201 shortlisted final-year students from government colleges across Delhi were awarded the BYPL Sashakt Scholarships, reaffirming BYPL's commitment to nurturing academic aspirations and supporting higher education. With financial assistance of up to Rs. 30,000 per student, the scholarship will help beneficiaries pursue their educational goals and move a step closer to building brighter futures. On the occasion of Holi, a handloom exhibition-cum-sale was organised at Green Lounge, Wazirpur, to celebrate traditional craftsmanship and showcase exquisite handloom creations while supporting women entrepreneurs. The initiative provided a meaningful platform for artisans to display authentic handloom products, promote India's rich weaving heritage, and strengthen livelihood opportunities. The exhibition drew enthusiastic interest from visitors, who appreciated the artistry, skill, and dedication reflected in each handcrafted piece.



Handmade Delights by Our Seniors

On the occasion of Holi, BYPL Head Office hosted a special festive stall featuring homemade food items and organic colours prepared by the residents of BSES Senior Abode. The initiative promoted inclusion, dignity, and festive entrepreneurship by providing senior residents with an opportunity to showcase their skills and actively participate in the celebrations.

During the month, the residents also benefitted from comprehensive free medical check-ups aimed at supporting their health and overall well-being. As part of this effort, consultations were facilitated at Synergy Eye Care, where nine residents successfully underwent cataract surgeries, further enhancing their quality of life through timely medical intervention.



BYPL Enhances Schools with Cool Roofs

This month, BYPL completed the Cool Roof project at Sarvodaya Co-Ed Senior Secondary School, IP Extension, with a specialised heat-reflective coating applied on the terrace. The intervention is expected to reduce indoor temperatures by up to 10 degrees, creating a cooler and more comfortable learning environment for students. The project will also promote energy efficiency and support sustainable school infrastructure in Delhi.



Empowering Communities with Fire Safety

BYPL's Suraksha initiative reinforced its commitment to community well-being through a Fire and Electrical Safety Awareness Programme organised at Bebe Nanaki Gurudwara, Dilshad Garden. Conducted in collaboration with Delhi Fire Services, the session witnessed active participation from officials of GTB Division and BYPL Head Office. Through expert guidance and live demonstrations, the programme equipped community members with essential safety knowledge, life-saving response techniques, and practical measures to prevent fire and electrical hazards in their homes and surroundings.



BYPL Expands Vision Care for School Children

This month, BYPL organised three eye screening camps for school children at MCD schools in Gazipur Village, Hasanpur and at Shahadra under Project Nayan Tara. Through these camps, 880 children underwent eye screening and 88 students were provided with spectacles. With this, BYPL successfully completed its vision care initiative across 15 MCD schools in East Delhi, covering a total of 5,347 students. The project focused on early detection of vision issues and timely eye care support to promote better learning and overall well-being among students.
