## BYPL Greening the Future

On 19th July, BYPL, in collaboration with the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) and Give Me Trees Trust (GMTT), launched a large-scale tree plantation drive under the Ghazipur flyover planting over 24,000 trees set to be planted over a span of four months. The initiative aims to promote environmental conservation, foster a sustainable future, and encourage community involvement. The event was graced by senior dignitaries, including BYPL CEO Mr. Amarjeet Singh, NHAI Chairman Mr. Santosh Kumar Yadav (IAS), Project Director Mr. Dhiraj Singh, and GMTT Managing Trustee Mr. Prem Parivartan (Peepal Baba). This initiative underscores BYPL's ongoing commitment to environmental sustainability and its role in nurturing a greener future.

In FY24-25, BYPL plans to plant more than 34,000 saplings beneath the Ghazipur and Anand Vihar flyovers and at the Central Ridge Reserve Forest, West Division, with maintenance scheduled through FY26-27.





## BYPL's Dhaga Vishwas Ka

As part of its CSR initiative, BSES has launched the 'Dhaga Vishwas Ka' Handloom Incubation Centre in Uttam Nagar, West Delhi. The centre is dedicated to empowering 82 underprivileged women while preserving and promoting traditional handloom craftsmanship. It provides training, resources, and mentorship to the women, with facilities including 15 handloom machines, 12 charkhas, a tana-bana machine, sewing machines, and more, encouraging both innovation in weaving and the adoption of sustainable practices.

On National Handloom Day, 7th August, BSES set up an engaging stall at the National Crafts Museum in Pragati Maidan, where it displayed and marketed a wide array of beautiful handloom products such as bed sheets, stoles, shirt fabrics, and dress materials. These items, created by the programme's beneficiaries, showcased the skill and commitment of the women involved in the initiative.



## BYPL Eye Screening Camps

Under BYPL's CSR Suraksha initiative 15 eye camps have been planned from August to December 2024. The first two free eye screening camps in August were conducted in collaboration with Ishwar Charitable Trust, unit of ICARE Eye Hospital.

The two camps benefitted 678 individuals by providing free eye consultations, reading glasses and eye medicines.
