# BYPL Celebrates World Environment Day 2025 with Young Change makers

On June 5, 2025, BYPL celebrated World Environment Day with over 50 children at Kalindi Aviral Biodiversity Park, embracing the theme "End Plastic Pollution". The event featured doing tree plantation, seed ball making, poster and painting activities and an interactive session on the impact of plastic waste on planet Earth. An engaging session by Senior BYPL officials — Mr. Alok Varma and Mr. Brahmpal Saini — highlighted the harmful effects of plastic pollution on ecosystems and emphasized how small individual actions can drive significant environmental change. The CSR team anchored the event, which concluded with prize distribution and treats, making it a memorable and impactful experience.







#### **BSES Basketball Academy**

In June 2025, Dribble Academy Foundation, supported by BSES, continued its basketball training initiatives at Sarvodaya Co-ed Vidyalaya (Begumpur) and BSES Sports Centre (IP Extension), engaging 187 students — 40 girls and 147 boys. The month remained active with summer camps, skill assessments, evening practice sessions and friendly matches. This month's highlights included International Yoga Day celebrations, a first aid workshop and life skills sessions focused on

leadership & teamwork. Additionally, 42 students were registered for the upcoming CBSE Basketball Tournament. A new partnership with the Directorate of Education, Delhi, was entered to introduce structured training for nurturing young talents at two government schools - Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya, Fatehpur Beri and Rajkiya Sarvodaya Kanya / Bal Vidyalaya, West Vinod Nagar.





# BSES Seniors' Abode - A Home of Care, Connection & Dignity

The month of June at BSES Senior's Abode featured the celebration of two resident birthdays, participation in International Yoga Day, and an interactive handmade soap-making workshop. Residents also visited the Prajna Foundation to join in celebrating the birthdays of underprivileged children — an experience filled with warmth and compassion. Father's Day was observed with thoughtful reflections and heartfelt stories, honouring the pivotal role of fathers in nurturing responsible citizens.







#### **Handloom Incubation Centre - Dhaga Vishwas Ka**

BSES in partnership with SAVE (NGO) is empowering under privileged women at Uttam Nagar community through its Handloom Incubation Centre, training them to create quality handloom products.

This month the centre received an order for 400 double bedsheets with pillow covers, along with new packaging boxes, which will help in increasing earning opportunities of the women. In addition, they expanded their digital presence by joining more online shopping portals, further enhancing product visibility and market outreach. This month 10 alumni were successfully linked with Udyam Aadhaar, which not only formalizes their entrepreneurial status but also open up access to various government support schemes and growth opportunities.









### **Solar PV Installation Training Program for Army Veterans**

In June, a two-week Solar PV (Photovoltaic) Installation training program was held for Army veterans to build technical skills and promote employment/ self-employment opportunities in renewable energy. Practical, hands-on sessions ensured skill development, and field visits to operational solar plants at Mata Gujri Medical Centre (185KW) and AWA CGHS Ltd. Society (300KW) offered real-world exposure and entrepreneurial motivation. Veterans also received job readiness training along with entrepreneurship guidance. The program ended with a certification ceremony attended by BSES CSR team and industry representatives offering job and business opportunities in Solar PV installation.





# **Animal Birth Control (ABC) and Anti-Rabies Vaccination**

In alignment with the Animal Birth Control Rules 2023 and the National Action Plan for Rabies Elimination by 2030, BYPL has partnered with Friendicos Seca (NGO) to do vaccination and sterlization of stray dogs/ cats across East and Central Delhi. During the month of June, 998 dogs were vaccinated and sterilised as part of the project, underscoring our dedication to public health and animal welfare.
