Tobacco de-addiction camps at Janta Colony

BYPL partnered with Society for Advancement of Village Economy to successfully conduct two tobacco deaddiction camps in Janta Colony, Yamuna Vihar division.

The first camp was organised from 27FEB2023-02MAR2023 and 94 people benefitted from it . The Second camp from 24-27MAR2023 benefitted 79 people. The camp was conducted by Dr Sajeela Maini who heads the Quit Tobacco programme at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital.





BYPL organises six eye care camps

In March BYPL, through its CSR SPARSH outreach programme organised six free eye screening camps with NGO partner Ishwar Charitable Trust (unit of ICare eye hospital, Noida). At these six camps free eye consultations including screening for cataract, reading glasses and eye medicines were provided to 2705 beneficiaries.
