At BYPL, our strength lies in the trust and partnership we share with the communities we serve. **Sparsh** is more than just a newsletter – it embodies our shared journey towards compassion, inclusion, and meaningful progress.

This month, we were honoured to receive the 'Doing Good for Bharat CSR Award 2025' for promoting STEM learning through Mini Science Centres – an initiative that has already benefited more than 55 government schools.

Some of the other highlights are: 1,113 senior citizens were provided free eye care, 1,600 school students' eyes were screened, 56 Army veterans started solar installation / drone operators training and vaccination & sterilization was done for 1,400 stray dogs.

This festive month, an exhibition-cum-sale honoured the skill and creativity of senior citizens and women artisans, making the event a standout celebration.

National Accolade for BYPL's STEM Education Efforts

BYPL was honoured with the 'Doing Good for Bharat CSR Award 2025' for promoting STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) education among students in over 55 Delhi Government schools. The award was presented by Shri Raj Bhushan Choudhary, Hon'ble Minister of State for Jal Shakti; Shri L. Murugan, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Information & Broadcasting; and Smt. Vimla Ramesh, Commissioner, Government of Maharashtra.



BYPL Hosts Eye Camps on World Sight Day

Three free eye screening camps were organised in October, including one on World Sight Day. The camps were held at Old Mustafabad, Kanti Nagar, and Mayur Vihar, benefiting 1,113 individuals through free eye consultation, reading glasses, and essential medication.



BYPL Expands Stray Sterilization Drive

This month, a compassionate drive in East and Central Delhi vaccinated and sterilized 1,400 dogs, taking the total to 3,500 dogs and 300 cats, in collaboration with Friendicoes SECA (NGO). This reinforces government efforts in urban animal care.



BYPL Hosts Diwali Exhibition to Empower Seniors and Women Artisans

The Diwali exhibition-cum-sale at BYPL's Head Office Karkardooma, featured handmade creations by the residents of Seniors' Abode and women from the Handloom Project – "Dhaaga Vishwas Ka," uplifting and empowering them to shine with confidence. Over 100 employees joined the event, which delivered remarkable sales.



BYPL Supports Veterans with Training in Solar PV and Drone Operations

BYPL launched two new skill-based training programmes for Army veterans this month. The Solar PV Installation Training enrolled 38 participants, covering solar energy basics, installation, and maintenance. The Drone Operator Training, with 18 trainees, focuses on flight safety, simulator practice, and live field flying at a DGCA-approved RPTO. Both programmes aim to equip veterans with future-ready skills for emerging sectors.
