Corrigendum – I

11. E - REVERSE AUCTION (e-RA)

The following sub clause is modified as under

iii. During the Reverse Auction the shortlisted Bidders will have the option of reducing the tariff quoted by them in decrements of one paisa or multiples thereof and to increase the quantum quoted by them by 1 MW or multiples thereof. During the Reverse Auction the prevailing Lowest Tariff would be visible to all the Bidders.

17. OPEN ACCESS

The following sub clause is modified as under

ii. Booking of Transmission Corridors:

BYPL is having LTOA in line with CERC (Sharing of Transmission Charges & Losses). The successful bidder(s) shall apply for booking of the open access transmission corridor to nodal RLDC on behalf of BYPL. Bidder(s) shall be fully responsible for the timely filing of open access application before the nodal RLDC and coordinating with the relevant RLDC / SLDC so as to get the timely booking of the open access corridor for the contracted quantum on advance basis.

The energy shall be scheduled and dispatched as per the relevant provisions of CERC regulations for Short Term Open Access(STOA) and Procedure for Reservation of Transmission Capacity for STOA (Inclusive of all the amendments till date). The successful bidder(s) shall apply for booking of advance reservation in such a manner so as to get the maximum quantum from the shortest route.

24. PAYMENT OF LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR FAILURE TO SUPPLY THE CONTRACTED CAPACITY

The following sub clauses are modified as under

ii. In case deviation from BYPL's side is more than 15% of contracted energy for which open access has been allocated on monthly basis, BYPL shall pay compensation at 20% of Tariff per kWh for the quantum of shortfall in excess of permitted deviation of 15%.

iii. In case deviation from Seller's side is more than 15% of contracted energy for which open access has been allocated on monthly basis, Seller shall pay compensation to BYPL at 20% of Tariff per kWh for the quantum of shortfall in excess of permitted deviation of 15% in the energy supplied.

The following sub clause is added.

vi. In case of revision of approved Open Access corridor, the party seeking revision of Open Access Corridor shall bear the Open Access Charges, to be deducted by NRLDC as per prevailing Open Access Regulations.
