**Proposed amendments for Smart Meters RfP. Part - I**

<p><b>General:</b></p> <p>The Company, BYPL, rated A+ by the MoP in RPM meeting, is in the process of converting the existing digital meters to Smart Meters and is accordingly inviting tenders for (a) Supply of Smart Meters as detailed in this document (Part-I) (NIT NO: CMC/BY/22-23/RS/SkS/SS/16); and (b) Advance Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Service Provider in another document (Part-II). It is the objective of the Company in the interest of the consumers to allow a Bidder or consortium of Bidders to also participate, if so chosen by Bidder, in both these RFPs, as one Price Bid submission, however, ensuring that the details in submission reflect the price breakup of each Part separately. The Bidder need to comply with Technical Specification for respective Product, Services etc. as stipulated in the concerned document.</p> <p>In such cases the Technical Qualification Criteria as defined under Part – II RfP for Sole Bidder/ Lead Bidder / Consortium Members at 4.2 and Financial criteria of AATO – 250 Cr in last three Financial years and Positive Net-worth 50 Cr., shall be mandatorily applicable apart from other applicable criteria for Meters, Product OEMs and services. .</p>

<p>1.</p>		<p>A utility company having Distribution Licensee having at-least 2 MN Consumers directly or through its subsidiary / affiliate is allowed be Sole Bidder or Lead Bidder in a consortium</p>
<p>2.</p>		<p><b>Added in As:</b> <b>Section 3, Clause 11</b></p> <p>BSES reserves the right to replace any Product OEM or Service Provider withan eligibleOEM or Service providerby mutual consent if BSES find better commercial terms are available from an alternate OEMof similar product capabilities or Service provider, as the case may be, and all benefits there from shall accrue to BSES</p> <p>BYPL shall give notice to AMISP in case of not executing its activity with efficient performance or services, as the case may be, the Bidder shall be required to submit a mitigation plan within 30 days of such request to be acceptable to BSES, failing which BSES shall have an option to appoint an alternate OEM or Service provider, as the case</p>

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		may be, at the cost and responsibility of Bidder. This will be without prejudice to the other rights and remedies available to of BSES under the contract against the Bidder.
