CEO Message

Dear Consumers,

Greetings on the threshold of a new decade!

In the year of the Common Wealth Games we, as residents of East and Central Delhi, will have to put our best foot forward as hosts in showcasing our city to the visitors that will be thronging our locality on way to most of the Games venues located in our area.

Last time Delhi hosted the Asian Games in 1982, the city's peak demand was around 600MW, in 2009 Delhi's peak power demand hit 4404MW, in the BYPL area alone, in summer 2009, the peak load met was 1057MW. It is no surprise then that, Delhi's per capita power consumption at 1265 units/annum is double the national average of 606 units/annum and other states want to emulate the successful "Delhi power privatization model".

For the coming months adequate arrangements for power have been made by your distribution company BYPL. Power supply arrangements have been set in place from the new units that are scheduled to be operational in Dadri, Bawana, Jhajjar and the Damodar Valley Corporation power plants. We are happy to inform you, that an additional 100-150MW power has already been banked with other states. We are confident with your help and co-operation in judiciously using power we will adequately meet the power demands in East and Central Delhi.

To ensure a smooth run up to the Games we at BYPL have already launched a massive preventive maintenance programme in our area for all 2235 sub-stations, 48 Grid stations this exercise will be completed by Summer 2010. In addition, two new grids will be made operational – the Common Wealth Games Village grid and the Sonia Vihar grid. The CWG Village grid will also provide relief to the adjoining areas of Mayur Vihar and Lakshmi Nagar.

While we revamp and upgrade our network, may we request that you on a personal level, have the loads at your premises checked to see if you require any load enhancement to be done. For any assistance with BYPL services just dial 399 99808 and we will provide you door-step service.
