Type BSES <SPACE> FAULT CODE <SPACE> CRN Number and SMS to 5-545-464

Fault Codes are:

(I) NC for No Current, (ii) VF for Voltage Fluctuation and (iii) MB for Outages on account of Meter Issues

Even Bill and Payment details are available through SMS. All you have to do is:

Type BSES <SPACE> BILL <SPACE> CRN Number and SMS to 5-545-464

## BYPL to bring home sun power



BYPL and BRPL have separately signed a 25-year MoU to procure 25 MW of solar power each with ACME Jaisalmer Solar Pvt Ltd. recently.

Through this agreement, BSES companies became the first power distribution companies in India to take the lead in showing commitment to the Jawahar Lal Nehru National Solar Mission (JNNSM) - an ambitious project for generating 20,000 MW of Grid Solar Power by 2020 - launched by Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh.

ACME Group is setting up three solar plants of 50 MW's each in Rajasthan (Jaisalmer, Bikaner and Jodhpur). BYPL and BRPL will procure the entire 50 MW (25 MW each) from the Rs 750 crore Jaisalmer Solar Thermal Power Plant expected to be commissioned by June 2011.

## Vishisht Sahayogi meet

BYPL kicked off the New Year by organizing a meet for its Vishisht Sahayogis in East and Central Delhi. During the meeting BYPL CEO Mr Ramesh Narayanan, shared the company's plans, challenges and efforts it has made to meet the growing expectations of the consumers. Vishisht Sahyogis were assured resolution of their issues would be given priority by BYPL.



## Keeping Delhi clean and green - BYPL to buy 'waste' power

To keep Delhi clean and green and to show our concern for energy conservation and climate change, BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) recently signed a 25 year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with East Delhi Waste Processing Company Limited (EDWPCL) to buy electricity from Delhi's first 'city waste to power' initiative.

BYPL will procure 49% of the 10 MW electricity that will be generated by the 'renewable' energy power plant coming up at Ghazipur at a competitive tariff rate of Rs 3.668 per KWh.

This 10 MW municipal solid waste power plant, processing around 1200 tonnes of municipal solid waste daily, is expected to reduce greenhouse gases equivalent to planting around 1.19 lakh trees or removing 83,000 cars from the road for a year.
