
#### **BYPL CSR Vision**

# LENDING A HELPING HAND

Supplementing the Government efforts, BYPL is doing its bit in the fight against Covid-19. In April 2020, we have provided dry food rations (like rice, pulses, atta, cooking oil etc.), masks, sanitisers and soaps at the door-steps of over 3000 residents of various JJ clusters in our area.

















## BYPL Suraksha programme - Hand sanitizer installations at 30 Delhi Police Stations

In support of fellow Covid 19 warriors, BYPL through its CSR outreach programme Suraksha will install 30 hand sanitzers at Delhi Police offices in its area.

BYPL CEO Sh P.R. Kumar, handed over 30 sanitizer vending cum temperature scanning machines to Sh Alok Kumar, IPS (Jt. Commissioner, Delhi Police) on September 28, 2020 during the installation of the first machine at the District Commissioner of Police, Shahdara Office.

Also present at the installation ceremony were Sh Amit Sharma, IPS (DCP Shahdara District) and senior district police officers along with senior BYPL officials.













#### **BYPL SASHAKT Vocational Training Centre certificates for 200 youth**

With the easing of lockdown, in August 2020, the 200 youth trained in Computer Accounting & Cutting and Tailoring received their completion certificates. The BYPL supported training was conducted by NGO partner SOFIA Educational and Welfare Society at SASHAKT centre in Pataudi House, Daryaganj from October 2019 - March 2020. Ten sewing machines were also gifted to the top students of the Cutting and Tailoring course.





#### BYPL hygiene pack benefits nearly 3000 families

In September 2020, BYPL CSR team together with NGO partners SAVE (Society for Advancement of Village Economy) and SOFIA (SOFIA Educational and Welfare Society) distributed over 2250 hygiene kits to people in East and Central Delhi.

Additionally, during the lock-down period, BYPL CSR also provided hygiene kits to 500 beneficiaries of the Mahila Shiksha Kendras through NGO partner Dhanpatmal Virmani Education Trust and Management Society.



#### BYPL offers SASHAKT scholarship for students pursuing final year graduation

## Over 2000 families benefit from BYPL hygiene packs

In October 2020, BYPL CSR team together with NGO partners SAVE (Society for Advancement of Village Economy) and SOFIA (SOFIA Educational and Welfare Society) distributed over 2000 hygiene kits to people in East and Central Delhi. Altogether, over 8000 cakes of bathing and washing soaps, 8000 reusable masks and toothbrushes, 6000 sanitary pads, 2000 toothpaste tubes were distributed to promote personal hygiene.









#### BYPL donates 3 ambulances and 50 hands-free sanitizer machines

BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) is playing an important role in Delhi's fight against Corona Virus. Under its CSR Suraksha initiative, BYPL handed over keys of three fully equipped ambulances to GTB, GB Pant and Lal Bahadur Shastri hospitals. Additionally, BYPL also handed over 50 hands-free sanitizer-cumtemperature sensor machines to Delhi's Hon'ble Power and Health Minister Sh. Satyendar Jain. Under BYPL CSR Sashakt initiative CEO Sh. P.R. Kumar handed over 300 Lenovo M10 tablets to Sh Manish Sisodia, Hon'ble Dy. Chief Minister Delhi. In turn, Sh. Sisodia handed over these tablets to deserving Delhi governmet school students to enable and encourage them to attend online classes.







## BYPL installs 60 Hand Sanitizer & temperature scanning machines

In the continued fight against COVID 19, under BYPL CSR Suraksha initiative, 50 Mohalla Clinics in East and Central Delhi now have the BYPL donated hands-free sanitizer vending cum temperature scanning machines. Additionally, ten machines have been installed at Polyclinics. Police stations, Permanent Lok Adalat building and other places frequented by the public to encourage safe hygiene practices.

As part of its Covid relief measure, BYPL through its CSR initiative "Suraksha" handed over 1 lakh gloves to Delhi State Cancer Institute(DSCI) in the presence of DSCI and BYPL officials.

#### BYPL Sashakt Scholarship 2020 update

Through implementing partner Buddy4Study, the scholarship has been offered to 135 deserving candidates in their final year of graduation studying in Delhi Government colleges. On 20th March, senior BYPL officials led by the CEO Mr P R Kumar, handed over scholarships to 135 meritorious college students from the weaker sections of the society under the company's Sashakt 2020-21 scholarship distribution program. Belonging to several Delhi Colleges, including AIIMS, SRCC, Miranda House, SGTB Khalsa, Jamia Hamdard, Hansraj, Gargi and Lady Hardinge Medical College, the meritorious students were given scholarships of upto Rs 52,000. These scholarships were distributed among the deserving students as part of the company's Covid-19 relief measures and the commitment to promote education. The most deserving candidates were shortlisted from the 2922 students who had applied for the scholarships.





## with disability

On 6th March, senior BYPL officials led by the CEO, Mr. PR Kumar distributed the aids/appliances to 134 people with disability under the company's Sashakt- PWD program. As part of the initiative, motorised tricycles, smart phones for visually impaired, crutches, MSIED (Multi Sensory Inclusive Educational Development) kits for children with learning disability, hearing aids, daisy players for the visually impaired, wheel chairs and smart canes were distributed.

In FY21, BYPL will support Clubfoot treatment of 20 children at CIIT clinic in Chacha Nehru Baal Chikitsa Hospital. This is in addition to the 150 children being supported since 2019, taking the total count to 170.
